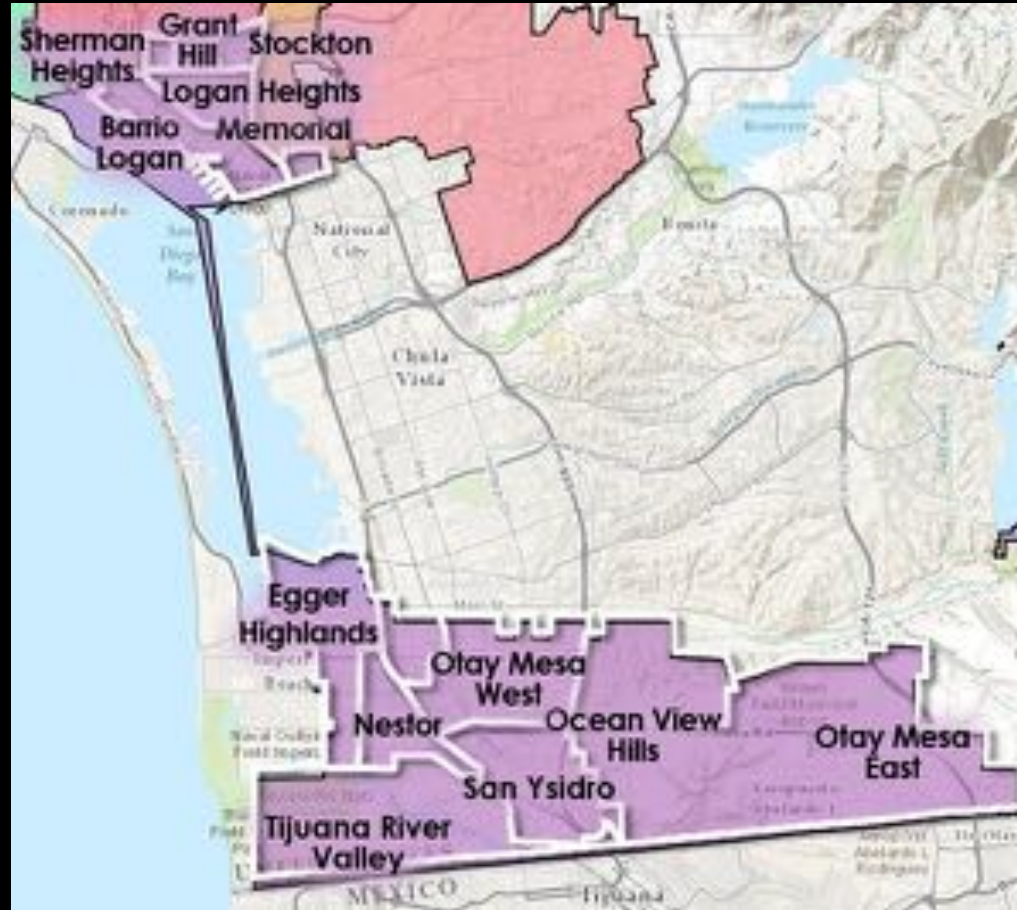

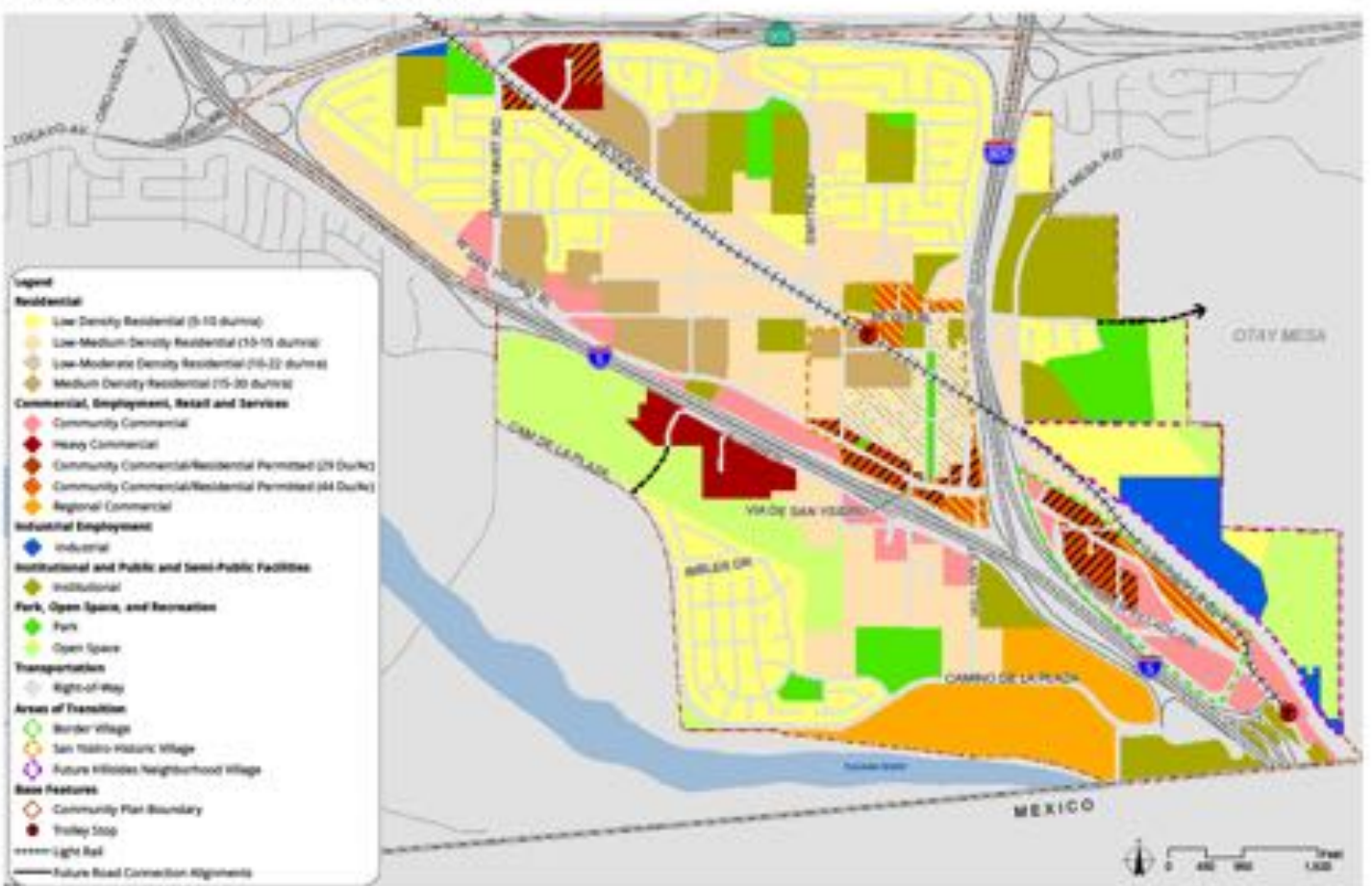

SAN YSIDRO COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE



Unique Characteristics

- One of the largest person per household rates
- Larger units for multi-generational housing
- 56% jobs in service, sales and admin support
- 28% jobs in construction and transportation
- Geographically constrained
- International Border commuter & visitor traffic

Update includes:

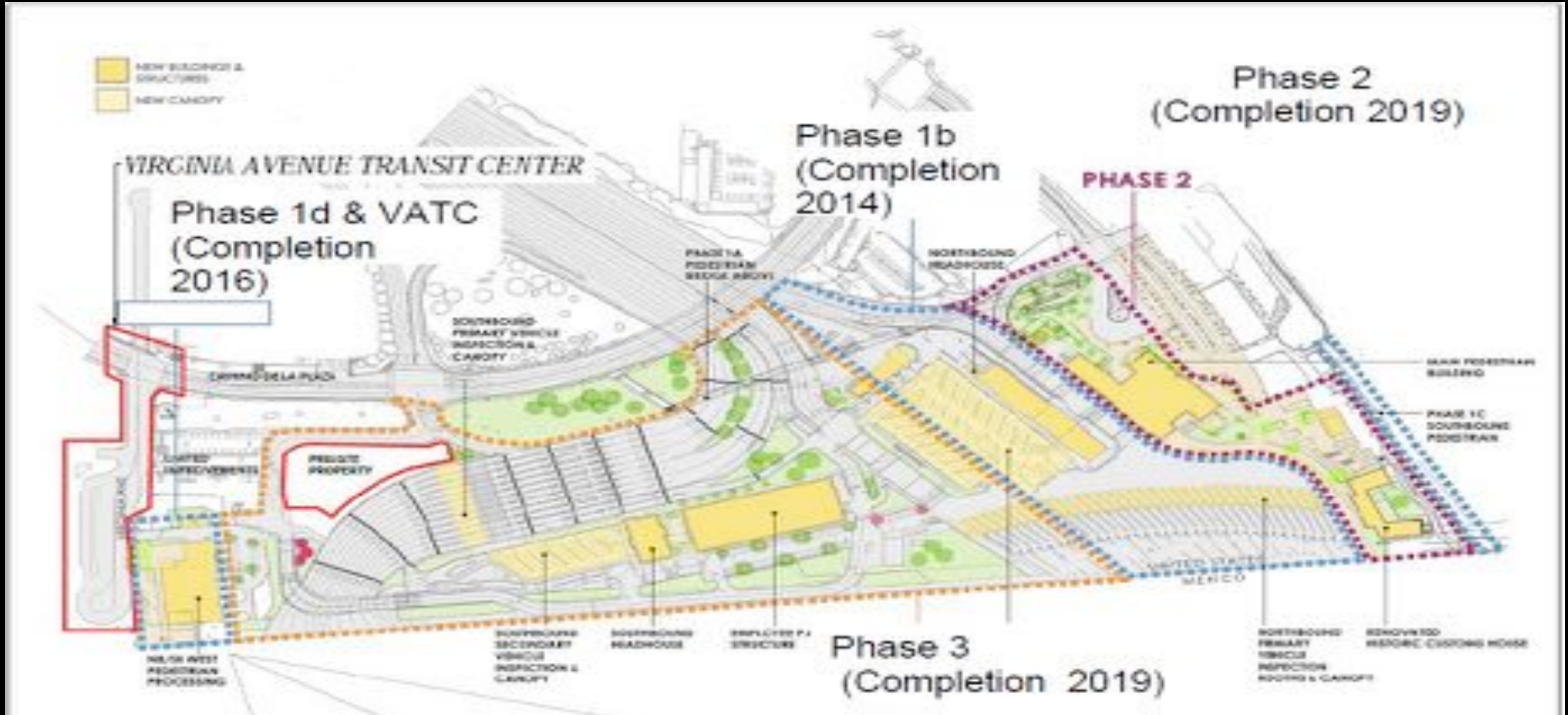
- Zoning changes

- Future Specific Plan for the hillside area

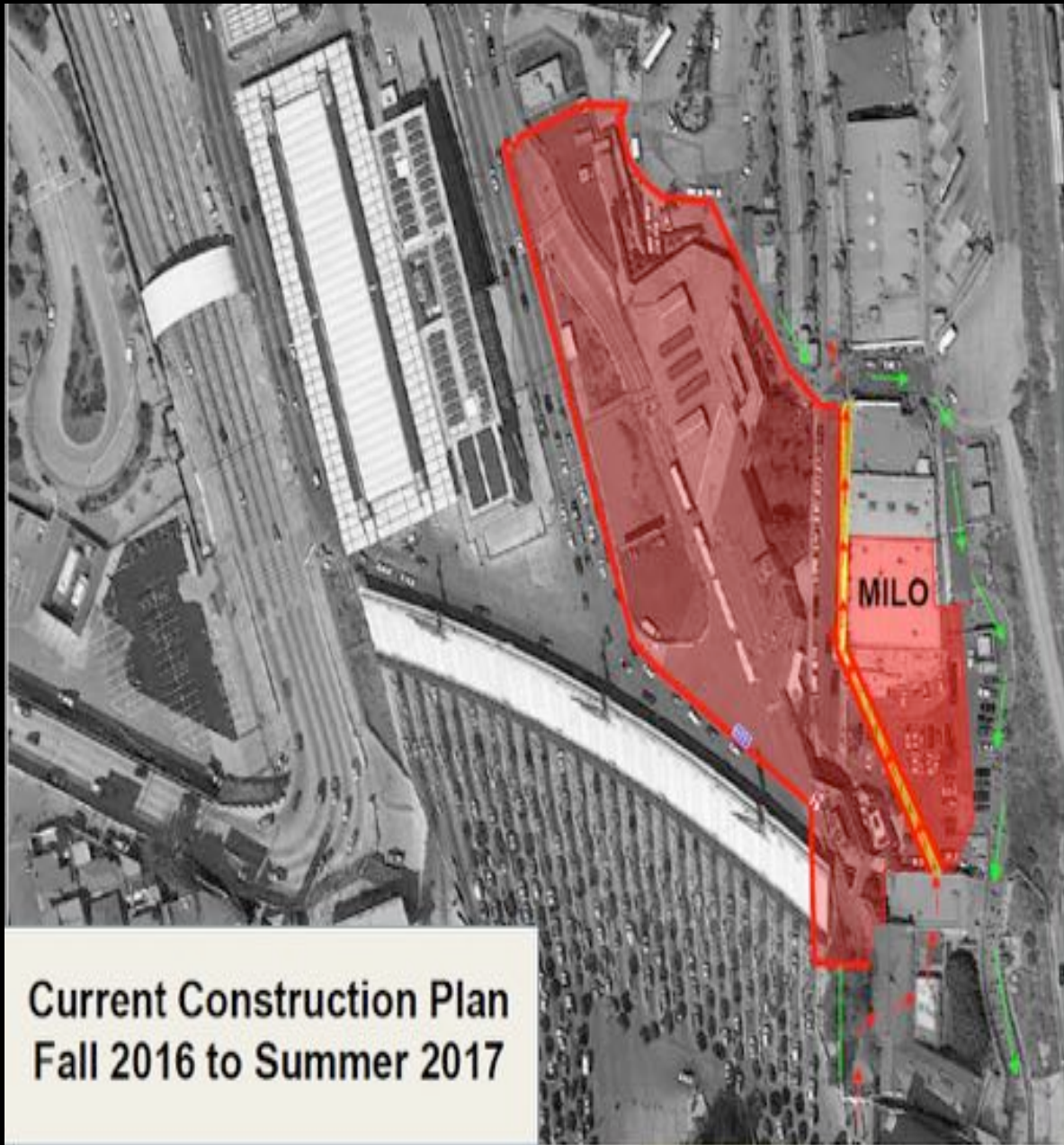

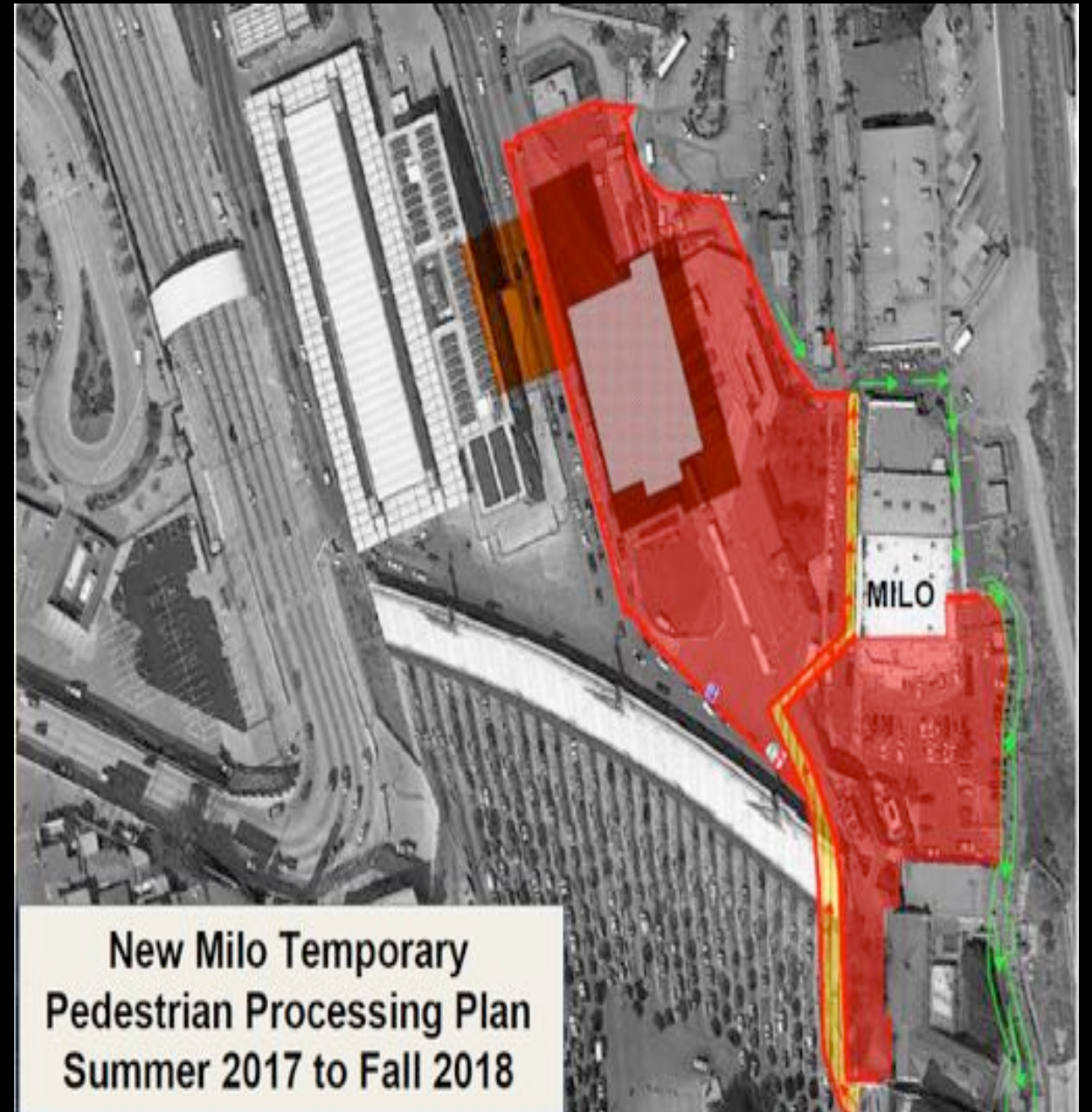


San Ysidro Phase 2 Project Scope

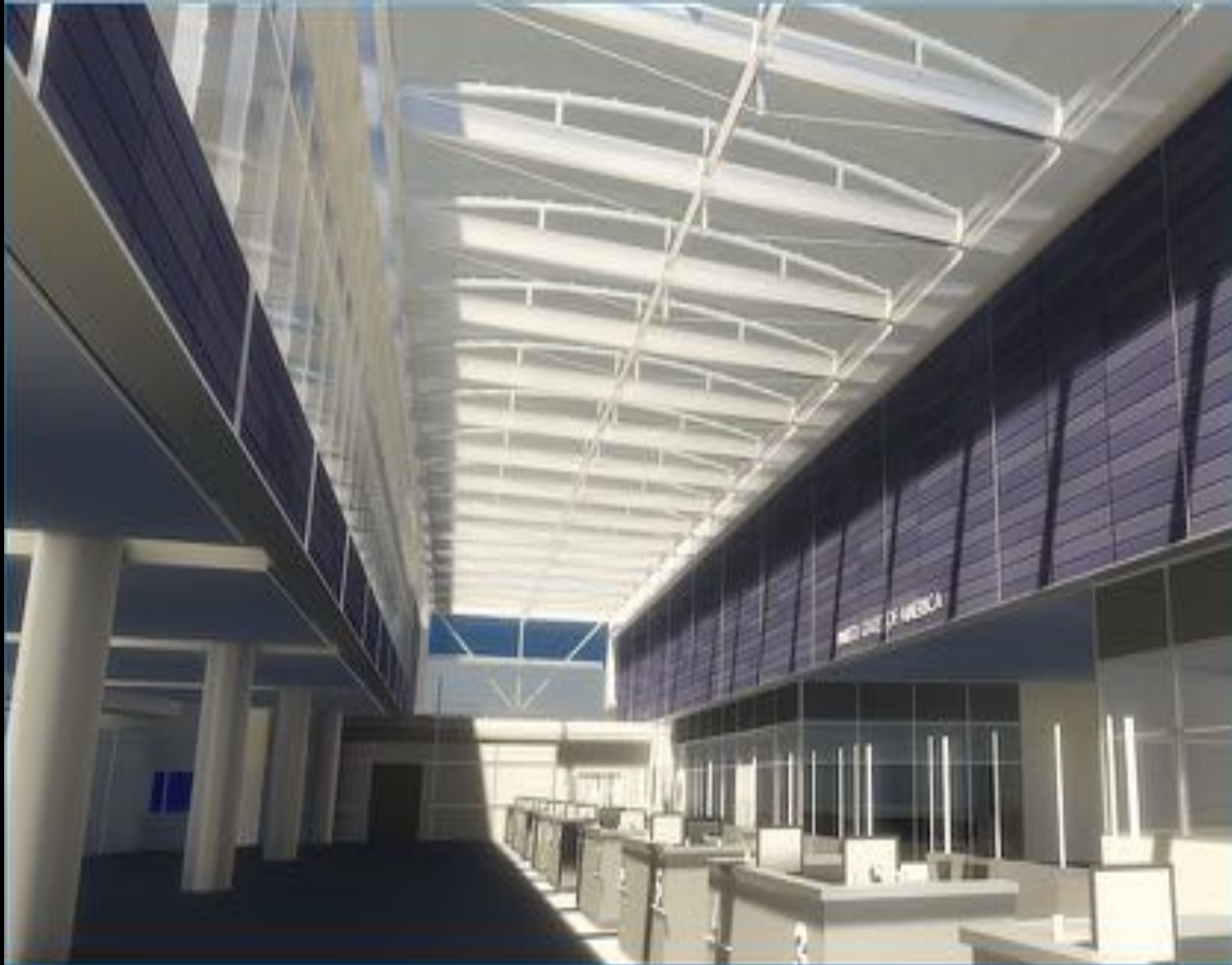
- New Northbound Pedestrian Building
- 22 Northbound Pedestrian Processing Lanes
 - – Historic Customs House Renovation & Southbound Addition
- 4 Southbound Pedestrian Processing Lanes
 - – Pedestrian Plazas and New Southbound Route
 - – 1 Dedicated Northbound Bus Lane

Fall 2016 to Summer 2017**



**New Milo Temporary
Pedestrian Processing Plan
Summer 2017 to Fall 2018**



San Ysidro Phase 2 Upcoming New Northbound Pedestrian Processing Route

- Summer 2017, northbound pedestrian processing will relocate from historic customs house to the Milo Building located to the north
- Provides a more direct route for northbound pedestrians
- More open space for people to be processed
- Allows processing lanes to increase from 6 to 8 lanes
- Allows renovation to begin in the historic customs house
- This will remain until fall 2018 when the new Northbound Pedestrian Building will open for operations

San Ysidro Phase 3 Project Scope

- Adds 10 Southbound (SB) lanes; and
- 8 Northbound (NB)
- Primary Canopy vehicular inspection booths
- SB Primary, SB Secondary Canopy (SC) and SB
- Headhouse
- Employee parking structure
- Expansion of NB Secondary Canopy, NB Support Building
- Employee Access

SB I-5 Realignment Start	Q4 2017
SB I-5 Realignment Finish	Q3 2018
New NB Lanes Start	Q2 2017
New NB Lanes Finish	Q2 2019

- Final Design and Fabrication: **April 2017- September 2017**
- Installation: **September 2017- December 2017**
- Completion: **December 2017**
